#TRANSPORTATION & ARRIVAL

Transportation to and from Bengaluru International Airport, between the Venue Sree Koramangala Indoor Stadium and the hotels, will be arranged by the organizer according the prior bookings.

No transportation may be available from the organizer without prior and timely booking; subsequently own means of transportation will need to be arranged in all other cases.

IMPORTANT: The arrival of all delegations must be on the 20th of August, until 11.00 am. Arrival time means time of arrival to the weighing room.

Teams arriving at the Bengaluru International Airport, should inform the organizing committee of their schedule, including arrival/departure time and flight numbers on or before 01st June 2024.

NOTE: The transfer of carried out around the clock for teams over 5 people. In case of arrival of teams (part of the team) less than 5 people, the wait time of up to several hours is possible.



#VISA

Any countries requiring the visa are requested to contact the nearest Indian Embassy or consulates to obtain the visa on time. The waiting time vary according to the countries. If you are in need of any assistance from the Organizing Committee, please complete Visa Form and send it as soon as possible to the Organizing Committee before 15th March 2024 by e-mail: 10th.atc@gmail.com.

It is much easier and quicker to get your visa if you travel as a tourist. In that case you should apply for a tourist visa and indicate the purpose of your trip as tourism in your visa application form. Most of the countries can enter India with e-visas.

• COMMON MEDICAL RULES VALID FOR ALL:





- To protect the health safety of all participants during the 10th Asian ITF Taekwon-Do Championships, the ITF Medical Rules and regulations will be strongly enforced by the local ATF Tournament Organizing Committee. - The international Medical insurance Certificate shall be uploaded to the each participants' personal profile in the ITF DB and will be checked during the participants' check/weigh in procedure. The organizer will not assume responsibility for any damages or losses incurred by anyone all through the event.
- The Organizing Committee will provide professional First Aid to the participants in the Sport Hall during the competition.

COMMON ANTI-DOPING RULES VALID FOR ALL :

Please, be aware that doping testing will be performed for Adult Male/Female competitors in the individual sparring and individual power breaking divisions. A competitor who declines or doesn't follow the direction of the Doping Control Official will be disqualified.

All participants must have the following valid documents uploaded to their personal ITF DB profiles prior to the arrival for the event. These documents will be be mandatory checked during the participants' check/weigh-in procedure.

Competitors:

Certificate of International Level Athletes Education Program ADEL Certificates issued from WADA upon the completion of the anti-doping e-learning program.

ATHLETE ANTI-DOPING CONSENT FORM (attached to this Infopack), duly signed by Athlete (Parent/Guardian).

Coaches:

Certificate for ADEL for High Performance Coaches Education Program ADEL certificates issued by WADA upon completion of the anti-doping e-learning program.

Please take note that all Anti-Doping certificates are valid for 2 years, the certificates issued before the date 18th August 2022 will not be accepted.

- COMMON ANTI-DOPING RULES VALID FOR ALL :
- THERAPEUTIC USE EXEMPTION (TUE):

Athletes may have illnesses or conditions that require them to take particular medications or to utilize particular methods of treatment. If the medication that an Athlete is required to take to treat an illness or condition happens to fall under the Prohibited List, a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) gives that Athlete the authorization to take the needed medicine so long as the Athlete fulfils all the mandatory criteria to do so.

The Prohibited List can be checked at:

• WHAT ARE THE CRITERIA YOU MUST FULFIL IN ORDER TO OBTAIN A TUE?

Dress Code for Competitors

- Competitors are allowed to wear <u>ONLY</u> the official ITF-Approved Doboks of the SASUNG or Dae do brands
- Competitors are allowed to bear their country name on the back of the Dobok jacket under the Taekwon-Do "tree".
- The Competitor's ITF ID number should be located below the belt on the back of the Dobok jacket.
- Competitors are allowed to bear their NGB logo or trademark of their sponsor on the left sleeve of their Dobok and itshould be located 15 cm down from the shoulder line.
- Competitors are allowed to bear their national flag (3 cm by 5 cm) on the right side of the front of the Dobok jacket at the same level with the ITF Logo located on the left side of the Dobok jacket.

CHAMPIONSHIPS RULES & REGULATIONS

General

- Every NGB must submit two National Flags (1 meter X 2 meters) and a USB memory stick with the National Anthem (45 seconds.) to the Organizing Committee at the onsite Team Registration.
- Program of competitions: Detailed preliminary schedule by ring will be provided prior to the competitions.
- The schedule may be changed during the course of the competitions at the ATF Tournament Committee discretion.
- All disciplines may start on the first day of the Championship. There is no mandatory order of disciplines in the program. Therefore, competitors and teams must be ready to participate in self-defence, special techniques or power events even before the sparring event.
- Only one team from one country can participate and that team shall perform Pattern, Sparring, Special Technique and Power Breaking except for Self-Defence Routine.
- The host country can field 1 member extra in Individual and 2 teams in each category.



APPLICATIONS

All participants must be a registered member of ITF DB. Applications must be sent only via the ITF DB online registration:

Only the ITF affiliated NGBs and the ITF Degree holders and the color belts registered in the ITF Database will be able to submit application to take part at the Championships.

Countries requiring a Visa to India should contact the nearest consulate. The waiting period after application of Visas to India might vary, therefore please prepare in advance.

Deadline for NGBs to ask for confirmation of participation: 15th March 2024.

All the information and the passport photo pages must be uploaded to the ITF DB, Passport is legally sensitive data.



PAYMENTS & PENALTIES

#FEES

- Individual entry fee: **90 USD** per competitor.
- Team entry fee: free of charge.
- Accreditation fee for the countries using their own accommodations, i.e. if not booking via the Organizer: 300 USD perperson (Note: after payment, these participants will receive only ID card and no other package services, including transportation, full board meals and other accommodation—related services).

#PENALTIES

- Any change on the Registration after 1st of August, 2024 is 150 USD.
- Late arrival of responsible person to the registration is 300 USD.
- Late arrival of the whole team is **100 USD** per person.

IMPORTANT: The last arrival of all delegations is the **20**th **August, Tuesday** till **11:00 a.m.**

It is the participant's responsibility to have full insurance coverage for all eventualities. India ITF and organizer will not be responsible for any injury or loss for the participants, before, during and after the Championship.



ACCOMODATION

The weather is Bengaluru experiences a moderate climate with bearable summers and winters. Hence the Bengaluru witness heavy tourists through out the year who come to visit Mysore (or Mysuru), which is only a 2.5 hours from Bengaluru, a city in India's southwestern Karnataka state, was the capital of the Kingdom of Mysore from 1399 to 1947. In its center is opulent Mysore Palace, seat of the former ruling Wodeyar dynasty. The palace blends Hindu, Islamic, Gothic and Rajput styles. Mysore is also home to the centuries-old Devaraja Market, filled with spices, silk and sandalwood.

That is why the prices vastly depend on when the deposit is paid—namely after 1st, 2nd or 3rd final deadline they will be accommodated on different packages, as it is pointed at the tables below.

Each package includes:

- Accommodation according to selected type of package
- Transport from/to airport
- Full board (breakfast, lunch, dinner)
- Free entrance to the sport hall
- Free entrance to the opening/closing ceremony
- Medical assistance during the competition days (only for injured competitors)

DISCIPLINES

Only ITF affiliated NGBs and ITF registered black belt holders can participate in Championship. The degree and age of competitors must be valid on their degree certificates and passports. Competitors must present their ITF Black belt degree card and National passport at the registration.

COMPETITORS:

- Two (2) competitors each division/category in Children Competitions 8-10 years old.
- Two (2) competitors each division/category in Children Competitions 11-13 years old.
- Two (2) competitors each division/category in Junior Competitions 14-15 years old.
- Two (2) competitors each division/category in Junior Competitions 16-17 years old.
- Two (2) competitors each division/category in Adult Competitions 18-34 years old.
- Three (3) competitors each division/category in Veteran Competitions 35-44 years old (Silver Class).
- Three (3) competitors each division/category in Veteran Competitions 45+ years old (Gold Class).
- Teams must consist of five (5) competitors + 1 reserve (optional), not necessarily, chosen out of the individual competitors. Each NGB may register up to twelve (12) juniors. Six must be between 14–15 years old and six must be between 16–17 years old to compete in the Team Sparring, Team Pattern, Team Power and Special technique.



DISCIPLINES

- The Competitors credentials will be checked through the ITF DB. No other papers of verification is necessary.
- Children Competitors and Junior Competitors must be at the age of 8 to 17 years on the first day of competition i.e. 21st August 2024.
- Adult must be at the age of 18 or above on the first day of competition i.e. 21st August 2024.
- Competitors must wear the official I.T.F. Dobok of Sasung or DaeDo brands only.
- Competitors must be in possession of a Blue and a Red set of approved type safety equipment. Other colors will not be allowed.

COACHES:

- Only one (1) coach is allowed in the square during matches.
- He/she must wear a tracksuit and gymnastic shoes.
- The coach is the only person who can make an official protest.

UMPIRES:

- The Organizing Committee will pay 7 days/6 night's Hotel accommodation for ITF Qualified Official Umpires per country (no drinks and city & international telephone call included)
- A maximum of seven (7) Umpires per country are allowed to officiate in the event: 2 Official Umpires, 1 Standby Umpire and 4 Self Paying Umpires.



DISCIPLINES

UMPIRES:

- The Standby Umpire will become an Official Umpire if there is any Official Umpire from another country who wishes to cancel his trip to the event. Then their accommodation and meals will be provided by the Organizing Committee. If the Official Umpire list is full, then the Standby Umpires will be considered as Self Paying Umpire. They will have to pay for their own accommodation and meals.
- Umpires will be required to carry out their duties as scheduled.
- Umpires must attend all the Umpire Meetings scheduled in the period of the event.
- The Organizing Committee will dismiss any Umpires who do not abide by the work schedules or guidelines and such Umpires will have to pay for the hotel accommodation and meals by themselves.
- The Umpire's dress code will consist of the Navy blue blazer jacket, White long sleeved shirt, Navy blue trousers, Navy blue necktie, White short socks and White sport shoes as laid down in the Umpire rules.

COMPETITION RULES:

- ITF Tournament and Umpire Rules will be applied in competition for both individual and team events (including Pattern, Sparring, Special Technique, Power Breaking, and Self-defense Routine).
- Weight classes and divisions are specified in the ITF Tournament Rules.
 Only the age groups are extended. Competitions are held in the following groups:
- 08-10 years old, 11-13 years old, 14-15 years old, 16-17 years old, 18-34 years old, 35-44 years old, 45 plus years old.



DISCIPLINES

COMPETITION RULES:

Important:

- The Competitions in Individual and team patterns for all age groups and ranks will be held on the single elimination (olympic pyramid) system both in sparring and patterns.
- The Competitions in individual sparring for Children 8-10 years old and 11-13 years old, as well as for Juniors 14-15 years old (ITF Gup holders) will be held on the single elimination (olympic pyramid) system.
- The Competitions in individual sparring among the ITF Dan holders in Juniors (14-15 years old), Youth U-18 (16-17 years old), Adults (18-34 years old) and Silver Veterans (35-44 years old) will be held on the group system with the group winners and runner ups competing in the single elimination pyramid.
- The Competitions in individual sparring among the ITF Dan holders in Gold Class Veterans (45 years old and up) will be held on the single elimination (olympic pyramid) system.

COMPETITIONS/ EVENTS

The Championship will have the following events:

Individual: Individual Pattern, Individual Sparring, Individual Special Techniques,

Individual Power Breaking.

<u>Team:</u> Team Pattern, Team Sparring, Team Special Techniques,

Team Power Breaking, Self-defense.

DISCIPLINES

2. INDIVIDUAL SPARRING

Divisions: Juniors (Black Belts)

Juniors must be 14-15 years old and must be 1st or 2nd degree ITF black belt certificate holders. Each country will be allowed two (2) competitors in individual sparring and pattern.

Sparring:

Female: - 40 kg, - 45 kg, - 50 kg, - 55 kg, - 60 kg, - 65 kg, + 65 kg.

Male: - 45 kg, - 50 kg, - 55 kg, - 60 kg, - 65 kg, - 70 kg.

Divisions: Youth U-18 (Black Belts)

Youth U-18 must be 16-17 years old and must be 1st, 2nd or 3rd degree ITF black belt certificate holders. Each country will be allowed two (2) competitors in individual sparring and pattern.

Sparring:

Female: - 40kg, - 46 kg, - 52 kg, - 58 kg, - 64 kg, - 70 kg, + 70 kg. Male: - 45 kg, - 51 kg, - 57 kg, - 63 kg, - 69 kg, -75 kg, + 75 kg.

Divisions: Adults

Competitors participating in the Adult age category must be 18-34 years old and must be 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th or 6th Degree ITF black belt certificates. Each country will be allowed two (2) competitors in each division.

The 5th and 6th degrees will only compete in individual and team pattern



DISCIPLINES

2. INDIVIDUAL SPARRING

Sparring: Adults

Female, 1st-4th degree: - 47 kg, - 52 kg, - 57 kg, - 62 kg, - 67 kg, - 72 kg, - 77 kg, +77 kg. Male, 1st -4th degree: - 52 kg, - 58 kg, - 64 kg, - 71 kg, - 78 kg, - 85 kg, - 92 kg, +92 kg.

. **Divisions**: Veterans (Black Belts)

Competitors for the Veteran Championship must be 35-44 years old (Silver Class), 45+ years old (Gold Class) and must be 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th or 6th Degree ITF black belt holders. Each country is permitted to register up to three (3) competitors to the individual sparring and individual pattern according to the weight divisions and grade for the Silver and Gold Class. The Veteran's Self- defense routine will not be included. Patterns for Veterans will be separated by rank, gender and age classification. 1st to 6th Degree.

The 5th and 6th degrees will only compete in individual and team pattern.

Sparring : Veteran (Silver) :

Female, 1st-4th degree: - 47 kg, - 52 kg, - 57 kg, - 62 kg, - 67 kg, - 72 kg, - 77 kg, +77 kg. Male, 1st -4th degree: - 52 kg, - 58 kg, - 64 kg, - 71 kg, - 78 kg, - 85 kg, - 92 kg,+92 kg.

Sparring : Veteran (Gold) :

Female, 1st-4th degree: - 54 kg, - 61 kg, - 68 kg, - 75 kg, +75 kg. Male, 1st -4th degree: - 64 kg, - 73 kg, - 80 kg, - 90 kg, +90 kg.



DISCIPLINES

3. INDIVIDUAL POWER:

Competitors participating in the Adult age category must be 18-34 years old. And in the Veteran age category must be above 35 years. Each country can register one (1) competitor in each category.

4. INDIVIDUAL SPECIAL TECHNIQUE:

Competitors participating in the Juniors, Youth –U-18 & Adult age category must be 14-15, 16-17 and 18-34 years old respectively. Each country can register one (1) competitor in each category.

TEAM EVENTS: Divisions:

Age group 8-10 years old: (Colour Belt & 1st Dan Black Belts) separate.

Only Team pattern – Each NGB can register 1 team (male/female) in Children 8-10 yrs category.

Age group 11-13 years old: (Colour Belt & 1st Dan Black Belts) separate.

DISCIPLINES

TEAM EVENTS:

Age group 14-15 years old: (Black Belts) - Juniors

In the Juniors (14-15) Team Pattern, Sparring, Special Technique and Self-defense routine events, the teams must include only competitors 14 or 15 years old. NGBs must register one male and one female team to perform all disciplines except self-defence routine.

Youth U-18 (Black Belts)

In the Youth U-18 Team Pattern, Sparring, Special Technique and Self-defense routine events, the team must only include competitors 16 or 17 years old. NGBs must register one male and one female team to perform all disciplines except self-defence routine.

Team events: Adults:

In the Adults; Team Pattern, Sparring, Special Technique, Power and Self-defense routine events, the team must only include competitors 18-34 years old. NGBs must register one male and one female team to perform all disciplines except self-defence routine.

Team events: Veteran (Silver & Gold):

NGBs must register one male and one female team to perform all disciplines. Teams must consist of 3+1 for male and female for both the Silver and Gold classes.
